



## Hilton Beach Waterfront



**Trudy Stevani's Goulash Soup**

1 1/2 lbs. stewing beef (cut in 1/2 inch cubes)

small amount of flour

2 tbsp. oil

1 large spanish onion

3 large garlic cloves

2 beef boullion cubes

salt & pepper

2 tsp. paprika

2 small cans of beef consommé

1 can of water

Coat stewing beef in flour. Brown the beef on all sides in oil. Chop (in food processor) spanish onions with garlic. Add to pan & sauté with beef drippings without letting the garlic brown. Add the beef cubes. Add salt & pepper & paprika. Add consommé and water. Let simmer until meat is tender. Add more water if needed.

# HILTON TOWNSHIP

## BUILDING PERMITS

### **BUILDING PERMITS entitle you to ....**

- A proficient review of building plans for compliance with all Provincial and Municipal laws and codes
- On site inspections by a trained inspector throughout the course of construction
- Assurance that the health and welfare of you, your family, and your neighbours are taken into consideration

### **Building Permits are required to:**

- Add a carport, garage or rooms to an existing building
  - Add dormers
  - Add structural features such as decks, canopies, etc.
  - Any structural work including interior partitions
  - Construct a new home or cottage
  - Construct accessory buildings such as garages, sheds, etc.
  - Construct fireplace or chimney
  - Demolitions (no charge for permit)
  - Enclose a porch or construct roof over sundeck
  - Excavate the basement to provide a full basement
  - Install new rooms or finish existing rooms in the basement or attic
  - Raise a building to provide a new or altered foundation
- 
- Scaled drawings and application forms are required for all building permits
  - Building permit applications should be submitted at least 10 days prior to planned commencement of construction.

### **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER TO OBTAIN A BUILDING PERMIT**

### **IT IS ILLEGAL TO START WORK WITHOUT A PERMIT**

Building permits are not required for work such as the installation of siding, soffit or fascia, the replacement of shingles or windows, provided structural changes are not involved, or for separate structures occupying an area of 10 square metres or less (approximately 100 square feet) - unless such building involves plumbing – then a permit is necessary. In those cases where a permit is not required, residents are reminded of the need to satisfy setback requirements as outlined in the municipality's zoning bylaw.



## Island Insight

### On Matthews Memorial Hospital

I attended the Saturday, June 13th meeting, sat and listened to the comforting words of our Steering Committee Co-Chairs. Their first words were “we should not be connected to any political party and we should not be affiliated with the Ontario Health Coalition, as they will try to influence our policies or decision-making.

Previous to the public meeting, I had heard that we would be called an “urgent care facility.” We were also told that the Sault Area Hospital has forever been our friend. So I went away and thought about it, then discussed it with a few friends. And here is what I came up with: Ready? I think politicians got us into this mess, why shouldn't they be held accountable and get us out, since they have the power to do it. Mike Brown stated that, if we worked towards keeping our hospital, he would ensure that it happened. We need to hold him to that.

Ontario Health Coalition people have seen other hospitals closed. Why shouldn't we talk to them and learn from other people's mistakes? I ask people who are following the provincial study on rural healthcare: Is it true that ‘urgent care’ actually means a clinic for minor incidents? If this is true, then our hospital

truly is as good as gone. This definition needs to be absolutely clear – not hidden in government-ese! We need more than a clinic where all they can do is hold your hand and say, “there, there” while you expire.

As for SAH being our friends, I don't know what to say .....I guess that decision is up to you people. Is it true that our hospital is allocated approximately \$5 million annually, of which SAH keeps roughly \$4 million? Is it true that LHIN officials and even the Geyer Report recognize the need to keep our hospital open? Is it true the Hay Group consulting review of July 2006 cited SAH as a ‘poorly run institution.’ How much have things changed since then?

I'm hearing that the “new” SAH is badly over budget. Other communities have had to suffer tax increases to offset such debts. Will we be put into the same boat .... and still have no hospital?

It seems like the ‘negotiating’ has been taking place behind closed doors, taken into the shadows, away from public scrutiny. This must not happen! There is an old English saying – “the face of your executioner is always very well hidden!”



## PC DOCTOR

**QUESTION:** My computer freezes occasionally and the mouse stops working. How do I turn off the computer?

**ANSWER:** Let's troubleshoot typical computer freeze-up events. Always, always, wait and be patient. If your computer is running too many processes, an occasional dead-lock might clear itself gradually. Fight temptation to continue clicking. Wait several minutes. No luck? OK, next determine if the mouse is at fault. Many home and business computers have wireless, battery-powered mice that stop working suddenly. Replace batteries from fresh supplies. A mouse connected via USB port will sometimes be jump-started by simply unplugging from one USB port and plugging into another USB port. Wait and test the mouse by moving it back and forth. If the mouse pointer on the display still remains frozen, we move on to checking the keyboard. Find the NUM LOCK key on the numeric key pad. Press and release the NUM LOCK key several times and observe the indicator light above this key. If the numeric lock indicator light turns on and off, you may use the keyboard to shut the computer down properly. Find the keys to the right and left of the space bar labeled with the Microsoft Flag. Tap either key to open the Start menu, then using the arrow or cursor movement keys and Enter key shut the computer down gracefully. In review, follow these steps when computers freeze up: wait and be patient; check mouse batteries; move USB mouse connection; and, check NUM LOCK on keyboard. Another alternative: press and release the power button. New computers will shutdown properly whenever the power button is pressed. Be patient, wait for computer to shutdown. If this procedure fails, press and hold the power button down for an extended five seconds. As a last report, disconnect power to computer by turning surge bar off. Hope this helps next time your computer freezes up.

**QUESTION:** My computer starts up all by itself whenever someone phones. Why is this happening? How do I disable this annoying behaviour?

**ANSWER:** According to Wikipedia, wake-on-ring (WOR), or wake-on-modem (WOM), is a special feature which permits an incoming phone call to wake up a computer from a standby mode. This would allow a traveler to call home and access files on a home computer. Of course, the computer must be connected to power and the modem must be connected to a phone jack. To disable this feature, turn the computer off properly, then turn surge bar off. Or, disconnect the phone line at the computer or at the wall jack. Or, go to the Control Panel, System, Hardware, Device Manager. Click on Modem Properties and disable Power Management labeled Allow this device to bring computer out of standby.

## “Let’s get it done!”

CLOSE TO 50 PEOPLE from every township were at the Jocelyn Community Hall on Saturday morning, to begin the process of determining if our area could obtain and support an ‘independent’ community hospital or healthcare centre that did not depend on the Sault Area Hospital for its continued existence.

The meeting was organized by the Committee for an Independent Hospital, which has been mandated by Jocelyn Township Council to investigate whether an independent hospital is possible, and if so, how to get it. Most of the meeting was held in an unlit hall, due to Saturday’s power outage, but they still managed to get the job done.

“We are certainly NOT “against” the Sault Area Hospital, as some people seem to think.” said meeting Chair, Mark Henderson, Reeve of Jocelyn Township. “They simply have their own difficulties to overcome, and their own priorities. We will always continue to work with them. Even if we can and do get our own hospital back, more serious cases would still require treatment elsewhere - in the Soo, Sudbury, London, Hamilton or even Toronto.”

“Nor are we “against” the Central Algoma Rural Healthcare Committee, of which some of us are members.” he contin-

ued. “We just feel that the feasibility of having an independent hospital should be investigated, and not set aside just because we assume it’s not possible! Let’s get the facts first, THEN decide if it’s do-able.”

“It’s also about getting our fair share of Provincial health care dollars allocated to our area.” he continued. “Other northern communities our size receive an average of from \$1,100 per person to \$2,340 per person in health care money. The Sault Area Hospital (including MMH and Thessalon) receives approximately \$110.5 million in funding, and allocates

MMH an annual budget of some \$800,000 on which to operate. That translates into a mere \$205. per person for us, even though we pay as much in taxes as anyone else!” he stated.

Martin Van Boerdonk, Chair of the ‘Independent Hospital’ committee of the Central Algoma Rural Healthcare Committee provided the background of events to date. “The next step will be to seek our own professional consultants, to conduct a feasibility study on whether an independent hospital is actually viable. If it is, we’ll move ahead with developing a ‘business plan’ to justify ‘bringing our hospital back home.’” he said.

The idea of ‘repatriating’ our hospital stuck a common chord with the assembly, many of whom are business and community leaders who endorse the position of the Committee. What’s next? “If enough people and businesses in our community endorse investigating the possibility of an independent hospital, we hope to secure funds from government sources to pay for the consultants and the feasibility study.” said Mark Henderson. “But we need to get on with it! The LHIN is already evaluating OUR healthcare options. We need to get our own ‘ducks in a row’ and quickly!”

Mark also touched on another sentiment, prevalent among the attendees: “Years ago, the Matthews family generously endowed our community with a special gift. For whatever reason, we allowed that gift to slip out of our hands. We need to pay the Matthews family back for their great legacy, by doing


The general consensus and attitude of the assembly was simple and to the point: “there’s a lot of work ahead. Get it done”!
