

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Dedication to a Fallen Hero

ON SATURDAY JUNE 4TH, a week after the St. Joseph Island Central School celebrated the opening of its new playground equipment, a similar but more somber group gathered at Queen Elizabeth Public School in Sault Ste. Marie. That group was there to dedicate the school's new playground in memory of Master Corporal Scott Vernelli, the first soldier from the Soo to die in combat since the Korean War. He was killed in Afghanistan by an improvised explosive device March 20th, 2009 while on patrol, leaving a wife and infant child in Pembroke and his grieving family in the Soo.

MCpl Vernelli had visited the school while home on leave at Christmas, 2006 to talk with Grade 1 and 2 students and to see the cards they had made for our soldiers serving in Afghanistan.

Two months after his death, Queen Elizabeth students decided to name their planned new playground after Scott "to honour his dedication to protecting others." They held barbecues, a garage sale, fashion show and collected donations, raising over \$55,000 for the project.

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The NEW Agawa Canyon Train Tour

MEMBERS OF THE NEWS MEDIA were invited to take a ride on the new-and-improved Agawa Canyon Train Tour on Wednesday, June 15th. IN HIS RECENT QUEEN'S PARK REPORT, Mike Brown MPP announced that the Ontario government will soon be providing new photo identification cards, for people who do not drive, and therefore have no driver's licence.

The cards will be available through 20 ServiceOntario outlets by the end of July, and all 300 outlets by 2012.

More than 100 people helped with the playground construction, including five members of Scott's Royal Canadian Regiment who had come from Canadian Forces Base Petawawa to take part in the construction and the dedication. Three of these soldiers had served with him in November Company. They joined local military participants from the 49th Field Regiment, 33 Service Battalion, Northern Ontario Area Support Unit and the Canadian Forces Recruiting Centre in helping with the site construction.

The playground features a landscaped area with a plaque commemorating that Scott "gave his life in service to Canada while helping to improve the quality of life for families in Afghanistan."

Rev. Miller who hosted the event, lead us all in singing O Canada and a prayer followed by a speech by Scott's father Chuck. Then a few words from the organizing committee and two presentations to the family and school by Scott's 'November Company' friends. Although the weather was looking a little sketchy, the sky cleared to beautiful sunshine in perfect time for cutting the ribbon, which was held by a group of students while Ruth and Chuck Vernelli did the official cutting.

The Scott Vernelli Playground is now open, and makes a fitting tribute to a dedicated soldier who did his part to help make the world a better place.
