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The 2011 "Relay For Life"

WHAT DID YOU DO LAST FRIDAY NIGHT? How about early Saturday morning? While most of us were sleeping or drinking our morning coffee, thousands of people across Canada spent their night from 7 pm to 7 am walking or running in the 11th annual Canadian Cancer Society *Relay For Life*, raising money for the ongoing fight against cancer.

But the Relay For Life is more than just a fundraiser. The 12 hour 'dusk to dawn' overnight event provides a unique, fun and inspirational opportunity for people to get together with family and friends to **celebrate** cancer survivors, **remember** loved ones lost to cancer, and **fight back** to find a cure for this terrible disease.

Here in Algoma, it was a night for breaking and making records, with 1,300 people in 120 relay



teams taking part in this year's event at Sault Ste. Marie's Jo Forman track. These dedicated and determined teams weren't messing around; they blew right past the fundraising goal of \$265,000 (up from \$260,000 raised last year) and pushed the numbers up to \$275,000, with more donations still to come in! By comparison, that's more than three times the \$85,000 collected by 400 participants in Algoma's first Relay For Life in 2001.

There was also a 'market square', where about 30 'vendors' offered everything from baking and knitting to haircuts and massages, with all proceeds going to the Canadian Cancer Society. But it wasn't all "work" either. The participants were also able to have a few laughs, taking part in the 'fun' Olympics and a digital scavenger hunt.

Although anyone can take part in the event, to qualify as a ‘Relay’ team, you should have at least 10 people, each of whom has raised at least \$100. The theme of this year’s event was “Fairy Tales & Nursery Rhymes” and both of our teams got right into the spirit! The “Island Girls” chose the ‘Hansel & Gretel’ tale, complete with costumes and yes, the decorated candy house. Their ‘friendly’ wicked witch stole the show, while the team sold – what else! – gingerbread cookies.

The “Island Red Belles” were inspired by their name, choosing the ‘Little Red Riding Hood’ tale for this, their third year as a participating team. They fielded a strong team, consisting of Cindy Underhill, Maria Smith, Anna McMillan (Team Captain), Linda Lauzon, Kirsten Young, Darlene Giunti, Denise Read, Gina Marie Wilson and Heather Broadhagen, who collectively raised \$2,103.00 in the event. Team Captain Anna McMillan and teammate Maria Smith especially feel an intense commitment to the cause, both being cancer survivors themselves.

Maria really set an example, walking around the 400 meter (1/4 mile) track 53 times!

In its second year as participants, the “Island Girls” team included 12 people: Team Captain Rita Cloutier, Gwen Hess, Leona Kohvakko, Joan Bishop, Karla Lacasse, Bruce Lang, Marilyn Lloyd, Suzanne Lloyd, Solange Nelson and Ray Stortini. Team members Susan Littleton and Trevor MacKay helped with the fundraising efforts, but were unable to take part in the actual walk.

All 12 really went at it, raising over \$8,100! In addition to



collecting pledges and donations from family, friends and co-workers, they also held a Garage Sale at team member Karla Lacasse's downtown Richards Landing home, with all proceeds going to the Cancer Society.

Team member Joan Bishop especially felt the emotional side of the evening, as the participants walked or ran around the track that had been lined with luminary candles in white bags, each of which had a touching message, dedication or remembrance written on it. "It was an amazing, touching event as the stadium lights are dimmed and the luminaries' glow providing light and inspiration to us," she said. Joan also went on to express the team's appreciation and thanks to Team Captain Rita Cloutier, for all the hard work she put in to keep the team organized.

Both teams would like to sincerely thank all who supported them and donated to this great event. And WE thank both teams for such a wonderful showing, raising awareness, support and money for such an important cause.





“I moved to the Island five months ago. The morning of Friday, May 27th, I was checking my mailbox as usual. When I came up the driveway, I noticed my dog ‘Max’ acting peculiarly. He ran in front of me and looked behind the house – where there was a large black bear! While the bear didn’t seem to mind our presence, he sure scared me!

Growling at the visitor, my dog repeatedly looked from me to the bear and back, as if to say “what do I do?” When I yelled at the bear to ‘get out of here’, he began running towards the bear, barking and growling furiously. The bear ran away into the bush.

That was the closest encounter with a bear that I have ever had – my dog also! He was a ‘city’ dog and has never seen anything like that before. I now feel reassured that Max is truly a faithful companion!”



Black bears are highly intelligent, powerful and potentially dangerous. Usually, bears avoid and fear humans. They are opportunistic omnivores. In other words, they will eat just about anything any animal will eat, including humans.

Adult males can weigh between 120-270 kilograms (250-600 pounds).

Adult females can weigh between 45-180 kilograms (100-400 pounds)

If natural foods are not readily available, bears will look for other food sources – primarily your garbage. Once bears learn where to find and get a non-natural food source, they will return again and again.

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ST. JOSEPH ISLAND MUSEUM MOMENT

THIS IS A STORY to make a curator's heart beat faster. It is about our horse drawn hearse which was donated by Leonard Barton in 1971. It was used by Ralph Nelson Sr. in 1914, M.J. Mahon and T.F. Simpson in Sault Ste. Marie. It then became the property of Barton's Funeral Home.

In 2004, Trisha Shewfelt wrote a booklet about the history of the Barton and Kitley funeral home and has kindly agreed to let me copy a few lines. She donated a copy of it to the museum.

When Leonard Barton was just a "young fella", Mr. Chesterfield (the local funeral director), returning from a funeral, stopped to offer him a ride home. Leonard being a young curious boy accepted the ride, and proceeded to pepper him with questions all the way home. Upon arrival Mr. Chesterfield stated "When you grow up I will sell you my business.

When Leonard turned 20, he took him at his word, purchased the business and after learning the trade, built up a very successful business. Mr. Bill Kitley joined him and later purchased it when Leonard retired.

Late last fall, a man called to ask if we would like to have the lanterns from the hearse. He proceeded to tell me "These have been in my father's garage for I don't know how long, but he told me to give them to the St. Joseph Island Museum after he was gone".

The lanterns were black inside due to the smoke from the kerosene. After many hours of polishing I discovered the inside was silver and they shone like a new dime. The light from that small flame must have shone as brightly as any head light does today. I can't wait to get them on the hearse.

There is one small problem: the back of one of them is dented and the post for it is missing from the hearse. If there is someone out there who can help me with this, please call me at 705 246-2672.

Summer Swim Program Coming in August

HERE'S SOME GOOD NEWS for kids and parents alike! The Towns of Thessalon and Bruce Mines, and the Townships of Plummer Additional, Johnson and St. Joseph are working together to provide a Summer Swim Program for children across the North Shore. The idea was developed as a joint initiative between the Recreation Coordinators from the participating municipalities.

The 9 day Swim Program will be offered in early August, at the John Rhodes Community Centre Pool in the Sault. The first 'week' will be 4 days from Tuesday, August 2 to Friday, August 5, followed by 5 days from Monday, August 8 to Friday, August 12. The classes will be from 10:30 am to 11:15 am, both weeks.

A bus will leave Thessalon at 8:30 am and pick up children in each community (the Highway turn –off for St. Joseph Island registrants). Parents will be notified about pick-up points and return times prior to the start of the program. Tentative plans include taking the children to Bellevue Park for a picnic and play time after the day's swim lesson.

The Program is for children 4 years and older. The Cost of the program is \$130 per child,

and the child must register for all 9 days. This is a break-even program that covers the bus costs and \$60 per child for the 9 swim lessons. A total of 40 registrants is needed, to meet the costs of this program. If this number is not met, the program will be cancelled and fees will be returned. Registration will be on a first come, first served basis and no more than 40 registrants will be accepted. The registration deadline is Tuesday, July 7. The John Rhodes Pool has confirmed that the 9 days is sufficient time to complete a level of swim lessons.

There will be 8 supervisors on the trip through Summer Student programs and volunteers from all of the municipalities. Children will be supervised at all times e.g. in the Pool, change rooms, picnic areas and bus.

Parents may be welcome to ride the bus with their children, however, space is limited so if you wish to ride along, please register early and let your municipal office know.
