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Abandoned Catholic Cemetery



This abandoned cemetery is located on the south west corner of Lot 8 of the U Concession in Jocelyn Township. Lot 8 is a 100-acre Crown Land lot overgrown with trees and underbrush, but a small clearing can be seen from the U Line. This burial site was used in the early 1900's as a Roman Catholic Cemetery, up until at least 1910. It is now Government Property (Crown Land) as the Church does not pay taxes on it anymore. It is believed that there was once a church located here as well, and it was relocated in the 1950's, but we have no actual record on this.

There are two graves with markers, however several additional impressions in the earth indicate that there are other unmarked graves there as well. Records from Find-A-Grave indicate possibly 14 burials, as there are a few duplications listed.

Though we don't have much information on this grave site, for the sake of identification, when we did our cemetery binders, we listed it as the U Line Cemetery. Over the years, many have asked where this is located, so we are very pleased that we have had a sign erected "U Line Cemetery". Our thanks to Gord Hawdon for making the sign and the St Joseph Island Voyageurs for pro-

viding the post, which they have generously done for all our historical signs on the island.

Last season we presented a dramatic interpretation about local people and events. It was such a smashing success that I decided we'd do something of that nature this season. I hadn't chosen a topic vet when Aaron Fisher contacted me and suggested his newly formed choir might like to be guests at Heritage Day. What a treat to have a live choir help us celebrate our Island Heritage. The St. Joseph Island Choral Society will be singing an original song written by Aaron. I recently asked Aaron to tell me what inspired him to write this song and he provided the following. "The St. Joseph Island Museum and the public libraries are great sources of inspiration and hints of little-known or forgotten stories of people who have shared this same land over the past hundred and thousands of years. That is where I found this account of an 1828 Great Lakes freight run gone amok. St. Joseph Island Choral Society sings at public events, Christmas tree lightings, AlgomaTrad evenings and local historic sites are places where we bring beautiful music to new audiences beyond the churches and concert halls where choirs usually sing. So there was the inspiration for writing "Wreck of the Rum Ship Hackett", with a little research and digging in the archives I too found inspiration in this story to piece together a historic program. Imagine having to leave your home and setting sail on the Great Lakes in the month of November. That's just what the passengers of the Alice Hackett did. The schooner left Drummond Island on a stormy day and became Georgian Bay's first shipwreck. You'll learn the fate of some passengers which include the Lepine family Angelique, Therese and Pierre, innkeeper Alexander Fraser and Lewis Solomon, the son of a government interpreter. Over 100 years later we meet Reverend HJL Wooley, pastor of the Richards Landing Presbyterian Church who recounts the shipwreck and the conduct of its passengers, Reverend Wooley is a supporter of the growing Temperance Movement that is sweeping the country. Fave Stevens is our guest speaker and she will inform us about the connection St. Joseph Island had in the Temperance Movement. For our grand finale the St. Joseph Island Choral Society will sing a sea shanty in four part harmony inspired by the Alice Hackett. Along with this informative program we will have homesteader inspired picnic games to try, our Old Time Photo Booth will be open, dress up like an early Island settler and have your photo taken. Refreshments will be available for purchase. Join us and spend an afternoon looking back to vestervear.


