Checking Out The Deer Check Station



With Deer hunting season in full swing, the Deer Check Station ran by Sault College and The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources was back in the parking lot of Stubbees Beestro. The station is ran by a mixture of volunteers, and paid students and staff and has been a fixture during hunting season for many years.

While virtually everyone on St. Joseph Island has at one time seen a deer out their window,

and everyone sees them out and about throughout all seasons of the year, the statistics gathered at the station provide lots of data on how the overall population on the island is doing, with year over year results to compare to. The station gathers valuable data on the deer population, rough locations where they got, and weight. Antler length and



number of points are measured, and even how many deer are seen per hunter is also recorded. While as of Tuesday the largest buck weight is still considerably lighter than last years, doe and fawn weights are up with fawn weights being higher at this time of year, and is considered a good indicator that they are doing well. The deers ages are estimated by examining the wear on their teeth.

Even if you're not into hunting, it's interesting to see the data they collect and to get a general idea on how the deer are doing. Later when all the results are completed and compiled there will be a presentation at the St. Joseph Island Hunters & Anglers club and, the data will be available publicly. They have last years information on display at the station.

Rifle season is from Nov 8th to the 16th.






