





Central Algoma Land Trust Launches Annual Campaign to Protect Local Wildlife Habitat and Green Spaces News Release For immediate release

Desbarats, ON — Protecting the region's most important wildlife habitat and ensuring the community has access to clean, safe, and vibrant green spaces takes dedicated people and strong community support. This fall, the Central Algoma Land Trust (CALT) is launching its annual fundraising campaign to secure the resources needed to continue its vital conservation work across the region.

Each year, donations to CALT directly support the staff, tools, and programs that make land protection and long-term stewardship possible. Community contributions help safeguard ecologically significant properties, maintain public hiking trails and natural areas, and provide opportunities for residents and visitors alike to connect with nature.

This year, CALT has set an ambitious goal to raise \$30,000 by December 31 to complement the other fundraising efforts they have completed throughout 2025.

“Reaching this target will allow us to continue our conservation efforts, expand our impact, and ensure that the places we all care about remain protected for generations to come,” said Carter Dorscht, Executive Director. “Every donation, big or small, helps keep this work going strong.”

Letter from the President

In a letter to supporters, Board President Richard Warren emphasized that while CALT has a new name, its mission remains the same.

“Our name has changed, but our mission has not,” Warren said. “Over the past few years, we have been very successful in establishing new preserves, safeguarding important habitats for wildlife, and ensuring that future generations can enjoy the natural beauty of our region.”

Warren noted that community education and research programs continue to grow in popularity, and new opportunities are on the horizon. However, growth comes with increased responsibility.

“Naturally, growth creates the need for additional resources to manage these lands and programs responsibly—and that requires increased funding,” he added. “For this year’s Annual Campaign, I am asking that you consider increasing your donation, or making your first one, to help us continue this important work.”

Donations can be made directly through the Central Algoma Land Trust website here. Donations are also accepted by mail, e-transfer, or in person at CALT's conservation centre in Desbarats. All donations are eligible for tax receipts.


About the Central Algoma Land Trust

Since 2006, the organization has helped establish sixteen protected areas, totalling nearly 500 hectares of ecologically sensitive land. In addition to land conservation, it manages two public hiking trails and delivers a wide range of community programs and initiatives, including bird counts, water quality monitoring, bat research, youth education, guided hikes, litter cleanups, and tree planting events.


