Fresh baking is available on Fridays and Saturdays from dawn to dusk at the self-serve farm stand. We spoke with Laura Stewart about the farm stand and their plans going forward. She mentions Harold is the

We first started checking out the Golden Rooster Farmstand, at 1484 F&G line, earlier this fall, when some produce was still in season. It's a cute place to stop with lots of fresh items available. While vegetables have long stopped growing, the farm stand is still open, and as long as there is no significant snowfall, they plan on being open until the weekend before Christmas.

Opening earlier this year, the Stewart family, Laura and her father Harold, started with farm fresh eggs, vegetables, and other items, expanding with baking

“Chief Gardener” and is already starting many plants in his greenhouse. She’s also quick to mention that while this creates more work in weeding, they do not use any chemicals or pesticides. “Mom raised us eating 2-3 vegetables every meal,” she says.

She goes on to tell us as the “Chief Baker” that on baking days she starts early in the morning and bakes for about 12 hours. “We use recipes that have been refined and handed down from previous generations.” She mentions several family members’ recipes are used, including the dinner rolls and cinnamon rolls, which everyone loves, were “refined” by her late mother, Martha Stewart. We can confirm everyone loves them, as they were gone before our last visit.

She tells us, “We began the stand because Dad loves garden- ing, and has a passion to, as he says, ‘feed the world.’ He doesn’t want people to go hungry and loves watching things grow. Af- ter retiring from the big farm in Thessalon and retiring from his engineering career, he revved



up his gardening, and has grown much more over the last 12 years here on the Island than he personally could use! Every 10 days or so, he would deliver vege- tables to dozens of people around Algoma. We decid- ed this last summer that the delivery “business” was getting to be a bit much for him, so we decided to build the stand and let folks come and get what they need themselves.” Laura decided to add the baking on the weekends and also mentions, “We’ve found that most people are far more enthusiastic about the baking that they are about eating their vegetables!”

The baking is really a passion for Laura, having pre- viously worked in development in East Africa for a decade, she uses a chunk of the cash flow from the baking to help continue to get “her” students through secondary school and some in university now. She has found memories of the students gathering outside her jungle home when they smelled the fresh baking outside her jungle home. The dinner rolls were one

Some of the students were also taught how to bake, which was a novelty to many who had never used an oven before, as they cooked over charcoal pots at home. They were also very curious about these cookbooks the muzungu (white lady) had, and they would browse them and pick out the next recipe they wanted to learn. One day a student came and said, "Auntie, please teach me how to make food for the angels!" After some discussion, she realized that he was referring to learning how to bake an angel food cake! Laura still loves her students dearly and is so proud of many of them continuing to work hard in school and some now mentoring and coaching other younger village children. As for the name Golden Rooster, we were curious, she says the name just came to her. They wanted something chicken related, that says they are a farm stand for farm gate sales, but they do have a real rooster on the farm.

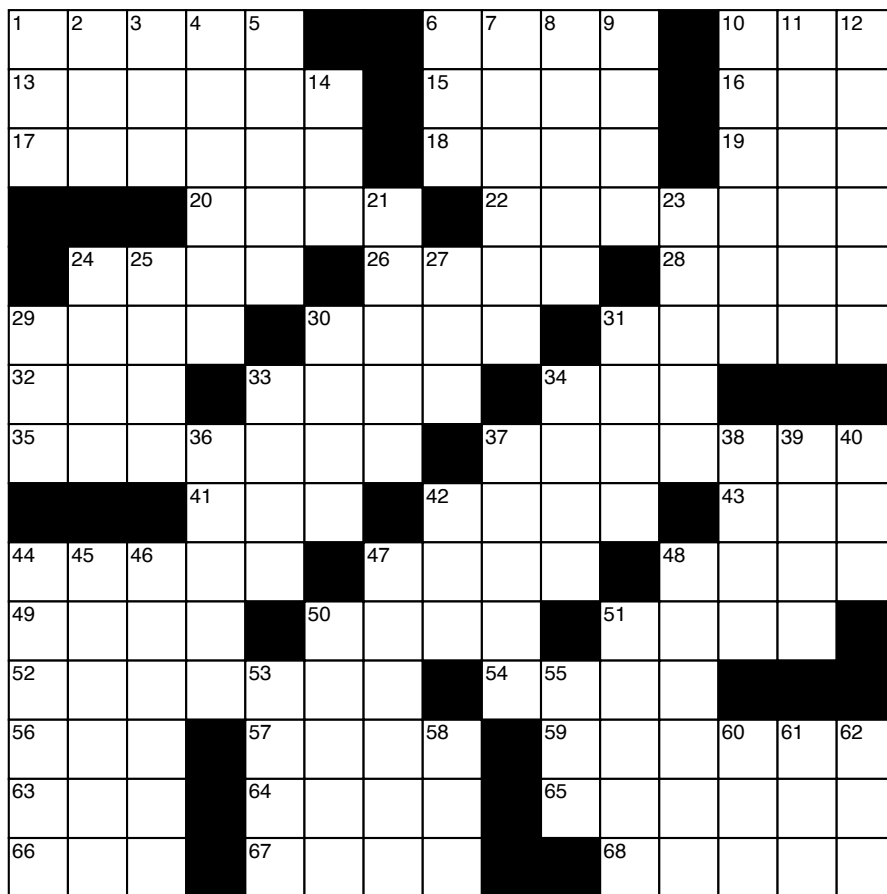
Coca Cola Caravan Including Santa visit Hilton Beach!

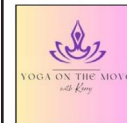
