at many community events. They quickly downplayed their part but mentioned the local Coca-Cola sales rep Jocelyn Adcock, whom we later reached out to for more information.



Jocelyn gave us more information on the event and was quick to credit the community for their efforts in nominating Hilton Beach. She tells us, "The sales team isn't involved in getting a nomination. I had provided details about the initiative to the Lion's Club and the rest is history!" She goes on to say, "The campaign is 100% driven by community members through votes on the website during the campaign. The top communities are decided on a per capita voting process so the more the community votes the more chance they have to win."

We asked if other townships on the island were considered and she told us that while every community has a chance to win, Hilton Beach was already in the top 10. While we have certainly seen some mostly friendly rivalries between Richards Landing and Hilton Beach and to a lesser extent other municipalities, this is a good opportunity for everyone to throw their support behind Hilton Beach, which is currently the only town in the top 10 from Ontario. There will be an update on December 15th.

All the voting happens online, and while we could type out the long link, you would then have to type it, so it's easier to just simply google "Canada's Kindest Community Coca Cola, or Coke" and it will come up. 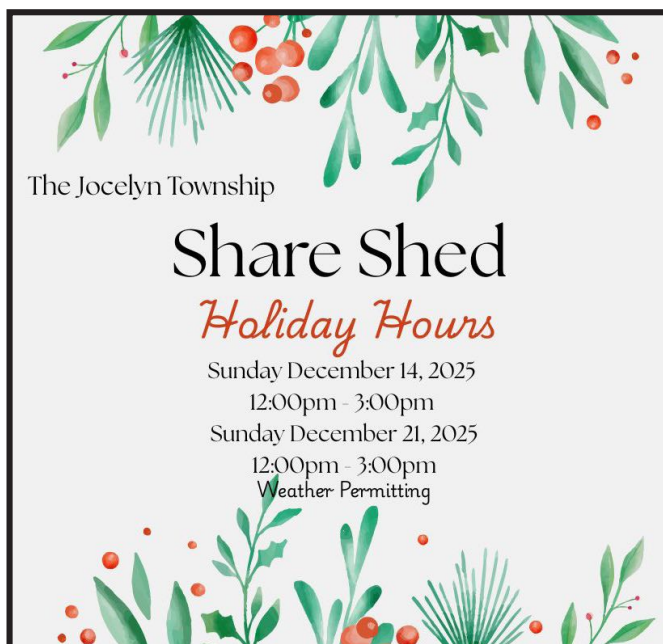

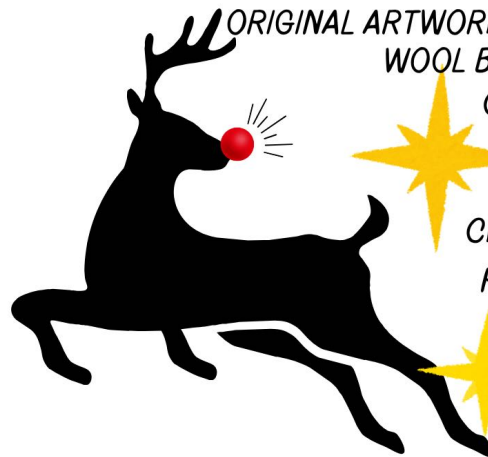
